Company Hygiene for Vegetable Crops

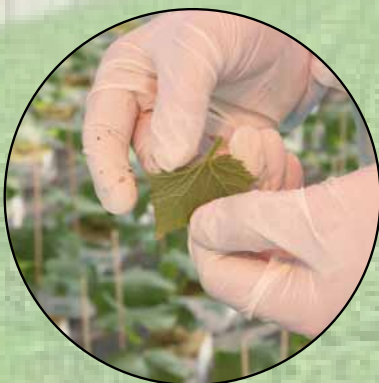


Prevention is better than cure... Good company hygiene as a form of prevention is therefore crucial for companies that produce propagating material for vegetable crops. Together with Breedwize, Naktuinbouw is organising training for Company Hygiene for Vegetable Crops based on GSPP: an interactive course in four modules held over four days.



The training

During the course, participants will gain insight into and obtain background knowledge of the nature of pathogens. They will learn how to recognise symptoms and which control measures to implement if any suspect plants are detected. Ample attention will also be given to disinfection. The basic principles of the 'Good Seed and Plant Practices' (GSPP) quality system will also be explained, whereby good site management and risk analysis are part of the curriculum. Participants will be taught how to critically assess situations in practice and how to contribute to introducing practical improvements. These skills can then be used to motivate their colleagues to work according to the hygiene protocol.



Subjects

The course consists of four modules: Pests & Diseases (two modules), Quality Management Systems (one module), GSPP approach (one module). The course will discuss subjects including the life and spread of pests and diseases, the content of the hygiene protocol and how to set up a company hygiene system. The relevant procedures and the implementation of the system will also be covered during the course.

Insight

The course will give participants insight into how pathogens spread and which preventive measures can be taken. After completing the course, participants will also know how to set up and maintain a company hygiene system.
