INSPECTION FEES FOR 2010 GENERAL INFORMATION

Naktuinbouw registration fee : see basic fee per sector

Documents/ labels (if desired/ ordered by registered company)

Supplier documents (all sectors) :€ 7.50 per block

Providing information to owners of Plant Breeders' Rights

* For each request € 156.00 administration costs and € 104.00 report costs per variety

* Other activities will be charged on an hourly basis at a rate of € 84.00 per hour with a minimum of € 250.00.

Issuing statements to companies

A fee of € 28.50 will be charged to companies for statements sent at their own request, regarding registration, variety maintenance, participation in the authorisation scheme, the GMO status of material, conformity of a variety, et cetera.

Naktuinbouw shall apply the low VAT rate when dealing with registered companies who have reported the fact to Naktuinbouw that they are ineligible to claim an input tax deduction due to the "agricultural regulation".

The fees were established by the Board of Directors of Naktuinbouw on December 2009 and approved by the the Minister of Agriculture, Nature and Food Quality.

This list of Naktuinbouw's fees includes the inspection fees for statutory inspections as well as fees for voluntary inspections.

Persons and/ or companies wishing to be informed about the fees for services rendered by Naktuinbouw (laboratory determinations, evaluations, test plantings, product descriptions, varietal trueness testing, consultation, et cetera) can contact the appropriate business unit at Naktuinbouw.

This overview of tariffs also includes the fees applied by Naktuinbouw for phytosanitary import & export inspections. The fees have been/ will be officially published in the regulations of the Ministry of Agriculture, Nature and Food Quality Fees Plant Protection Service and Inspection Services.
For your information, page 16 lists the fees for import & export inspections, as applicable from 1 January 2010.

FLORICULTURE CROPS SECTOR

GENERAL

There is an annual basic contribution for general inspection for each company (production company/ trading company) that is registered as part of the floricultural crops sector.

- production/ trading companies	: €	650.00
- production companies (turnover > € 100,000.00)	: €	325.00
- trading companies (turnover < € 100,000.00)	: €	250.00
- retail/ processing:	: €	100.00

This fee includes an annual administrative inspection/audit.

Plant passport

Companies that trade propagating material which requires a plant passport must obtain an agreement from Naktuinbouw in order to be able to issue plant passports independently subject to certain conditions. A plant passport fee will be charged for this agreement:

- production/ trading companies (turnover > € 100,000.00)	: €	750.00
- wholesale and/ or trading companies (turnover < € 100,000.00)	: €	250.00

This fee includes an annual administrative inspection/audit.

FLOWER SEED PRODUCTION GROUP

Flower seeds

a. Fee turnover flower seeds

A fee will be charged over the gross proceeds of flower seeds, in accordance with the rates indicated below. The minimum fee due is € 50.00 per company.

a1. Domestic turnover

- as based on turnover up to € 200,000.00: 0.20% of turnover
- exceeding : € 200,000.00: € 400.00 + 0.12% of turnover exceeding € 200,000.00

a2. Export

- as based on 0.10% of turnover.

b. Fee applying to the retail trade in flower seeds

A registered company selling flower seeds to consumers shall be charged a fee, in accordance with the following rates, based on his sale of flower seeds. Insofar as trading is done through and/ or to retailers (warehouse and/ or other retailers not registered with Naktuinbouw), the fee shall be based on net turnover (i.e. after deducting discounts and returns).

Of the total turnover:

- up to € 200,000.00 : 0.60% of turnover (minimum fee due: € 50.00 per company)
- € 200,000.00 to € 400,000.00 : € 1,200.00 + 0.50% of turnover, in so far as this exceeds € 200,000.00
- more than € 400,000.00 : € 2,200.00 + 0.40% of turnover, in so far as this exceeds € 400,000.00

ANNUAL REPORT FOR TRADED PROPAGATING MATERIAL (CUT FLOWERS, INDOOR PLANTS, BEDDING PLANTS, ALSTROEMERIA AND GREENHOUSE ROSES)

The following rules apply to fees for propagating material traded during 2010:

1. A preliminary fee shall be established as based on the turnover figures given in the company's annual report for 2009 (as stated in terms of currency or the number of items traded) and invoiced by means of prepayment statements.
2. As based on the company's turnover figures for 2011, the definite fee shall be established in 2010 at which time a final settlement shall take place (definitive contribution -/- provisional contribution).
3. In determining the quantity of traded propagating material, the registered companies can deduct the quantity of propagating material purchased from Naktuinbouw registered and then sold. Royalties invoiced separately to third parties can be deducted from the submitted turnover figures.
4. If the required turnover report over 2009 has not been received by Naktuinbouw by 15 March 2010, Naktuinbouw will estimate this figure. In this case, an additional cost of € 96.00 will be charged.

ANNUAL REPORT FOR FINANCIAL TURNOVER FLOWER SEED/ FLOWER SEEDLING/ OTHER CUTFLOWER GROUP/ OTHER INDOOR PLANTS/ TRADING COMPANIES

1. In April 2010, Naktuinbouw will send all the registered companies a turnover form for 2009.
2. If the required turnover report for 2009 has not been received by Naktuinbouw by 15 July 2010, Naktuinbouw will estimate this figure. In this case, an additional cost of € 96.00 will be charged.

In the event that travelling time is payable, this will be charged at € 52.00 per hour.

ARBORICULTURE CROP SECTOR

GENERAL

1. Hourly fee

An hourly fee of € 75.00 shall be charged for field inspections, lot inspections and specific audits. The minimum charge shall be equal to the charge for a half-hour visit.

2. Standard fee

Each registered company (regardless of production quantities or turnover) shall pay a standard fee for inspections in the amount of € 200.00. Included in this amount is the time required for the annual audit and the charge for the first half-hectare in production. This standard fee also applies to trading companies (not involved in their own production).

3. Fee based on size of company (area fee/ turnover fee)

The registered company shall be charged an inspection fee based on the gross number of hectares being used for the production of arboriculture crops requiring inspection. The first half-hectare or € 5,000.00 turnover is included in the standard fee and exempt from an inspection/turnover fee.

Size of company

a.	0 – 0.5 hectare	: Only the standard fee
b.	0.5 – 1.0 hectare	: € 1.61 for each 100 m ² more than 0.5 hectare
c.	1.0 – 1.5 hectares	: € 80.60 + € 1.46 for each 100 m ² exceeding 1.0 hectare

Note:

- I) Instead of being charged as based on their number of hectares in production, companies can choose to be charged as based on their turnover. This choice must be made in advance and for a period that will cover three years. In such a case, the fee based on turnover shall amount to 1.5% of the company's annual gross turnover in arboriculture material. Last season's final turnover figures, which are always reported in June, must be accompanied by an auditor's report, a statement by a certified bookkeeping agency or the PT turnover report.
- II) A discount shall be awarded in cases in which Naktuinbouw can establish ahead of time that the inspection activities for a product can be carried out extensively instead of intensively. The amount to be deducted will be € 0.49 per 100 m² as based on the number of hectares in production (as determined under section 3). Products to which phytosanitary regulations apply (including products that require plant passports) or crops to which the EU-directive forestry propagation material applies shall not be eligible to receive this discount.

In 2010, the discount shall apply to:

- The number of hectares planted in buxus, conifers and hedging material when any of the lots cover an area exceeding 2,500 m².
- The number of hectares planted in rootstocks for the propagation of rose shrubs or standard roses when the company's total number of hectares planted in these rootstocks is at least 5,000 m².

4. Repeat inspection fee

If a repeat inspection involving extra attention to notifications/ administrative matters has to be carried out on a company, an inspection fee of € 96.00 will be charged in addition to the hourly rate (€ 75.00).

CERTIFICATION

Registered companies having chosen to participate in the certification of arboriculture materials shall be charged the following fees in addition to the basic fees:

Hourly fee

An hourly fee of € 75.00 shall be charged for specific certification inspections. This hourly fee shall be € 96.00 when an inspection is carried out in countries other than the Netherlands and shall not include the required travel and accommodation expenses.

Forestry propagating material

A fee of € 28.50 is charged for each basic certificate issued. The charge for the approval of seeds for "non-arboricultural purposes" to be marketed or sown on the company's own premises is also € 28.50.

Forestry propagating material (plants)

An annual fee of € 12.00 per produced lot of forestry propagating material on request of the company. This fee also applies if, on request of the registered company, Naktuinbouw certifies material of 'non-directive crops' for forestry use.

Forestry propagating material (seeds)

These fees apply to seeds collected by the registered company (or under his authority) that will be used to sell or will be used as propagating material at the company's own facilities (irrespective of category SI, S, Q of T).

ESTABLISHING THE PRODUCTION AREA OF THE TREE NURSERY/ PERENNIALS

Statement field inspection

Each year at the beginning of the growing season, the registered company must submit a statement to Naktuinbouw detailing the plot uses by the company for production and the crops grown on these plots. This form must be sent to Naktuinbouw before a by Naktuinbouw fixed date. If Naktuinbouw receives the form after that date, additional costs of € 25.00 will be charged per field inspection form.

Availability

If this information is not made available, or not made available on time via a signed registration form for the field inspection, Naktuinbouw shall estimate this figure and an additional cost of € 96.00 will be charged.

Basis registration

The registered company must indicate the total surface in production per plot. If a statement has been submitted before basic registration of plots, the number of hectares in production will be established based on this statement. A copy must be made available for Naktuinbouw.

Plot surface area

The total surface area of the plot as reported to Naktuinbouw, is the surface area from the edge of the plot to the edge of the plot. When establishing the 'gross production area' the following are excluded: the surface area of the yard, buildings, areas used permanently for heeling in, water reservoirs, tunnels and greenhouses used for overwintering. In so far as there are pathways (not used for cultivation purposes and therefore permanent) wider than two metres, their surface area will not be included in the calculation of the total number of hectares in production. Paths and paths used for spraying purposes that run through the crops will be included in the calculation of the gross surface area!

In cases (for example, the cultivation of avenue trees) where a considerable number of the trees (more than 50%) has already been lifted before the growing season (before 1 May), a proportional percentage will be deducted from the total area.

Measurement uncertainty

In the event of any uncertainty/ discussion about the number of hectares of land in production submitted by a company, Naktuinbouw will carry out a post-measurement of the area (using methods including GPS). Where necessary a correction will be made to the submitted number of hectares in production.

PCN-testing declaration

Insofar as open field plots are under production, which have not at an earlier stage (recently) been inspected by Naktuinbouw, a copy of the PCN-testing declaration and a sketch of the plot must accompany the statement.

EXPLANATION IN REGARD TO TURNOVER FIGURES

In regard to the turnover obtained from the sale of vegetable seeds and vegetable plants, "turnover" is defined as the total amount, excluding VAT, of all the invoices issued by the registered companies for the sale and delivery of propagating material.

In special cases, the registered company can submit a request to Naktuinbouw in regard to reconsidering these turnover figures. In such a case, the registered company would inform Naktuinbouw that a substantial percentage of the company's turnover is being generated by the simultaneous sale of materials entirely unrelated to seed or plants (e.g. gift packaging, ornamental pots, books, etc.). Naktuinbouw would then assess this request. If it is demonstrated, as based on such items as evidence submitted by the registered company, that this is indeed the case, a corresponding amount shall be deducted from the turnover figures.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

General Terms and Conditions of Naktuinbouw for services or the performance of projects

Registered under no. 41150707 with the Chamber of Commerce and Industry 'Rijnland' in Leiden, the Netherlands, November 2009

Article 1 General

1. These General Terms and Conditions of Naktuinbouw apply to all offers, order confirmations and agreements on the provision of services or the performance of projects, made or performed by Naktuinbouw or to which Naktuinbouw is a party.
2. Any varying provisions will apply only if so agreed by the parties in writing and in that case only to the agreement for which such provisions are drawn up; the present General Terms and Conditions will otherwise continue to apply.
3. Any general terms and conditions of the customer will apply to the offers of and to the agreements with Naktuinbouw referred to in paragraph 1 only if and in so far as they do not conflict with these General Terms and Conditions. In the event of doubt as to the existence of any such conflict, the General Terms and Conditions of Naktuinbouw will prevail.
4. An agreement governed by these General Terms and Conditions will not be concluded until Naktuinbouw has confirmed in writing that it accepts the offer or the assignment of the customer. The parties may also prove the conclusion of the agreements by other means, however.
5. Once a customer has concluded an agreement with Naktuinbouw to which these General Terms and Conditions apply, it will be deemed to have tacitly accepted the applicability of these General Terms and Conditions to any later offer made by Naktuinbouw or to any later agreements concluded with Naktuinbouw.
6. In these General Terms and Conditions, 'customer' means any party, either a natural person or a legal entity that instructs Naktuinbouw to provide services. 'Assignment' means any services provided, work performed, advice given, and projects or other activities performed by Naktuinbouw at the customer's instructions against the payment of a price (or hourly price) or other fee.

Article 2 Liability

1. All assignments will be performed by Naktuinbouw to the best of its knowledge and abilities. Naktuinbouw does not accept any liability for indirect costs or consequential damage or loss. Naktuinbouw's liability for direct costs and direct damage or loss, howsoever related to or caused by a mistake or defect in the product or service delivered, will always be limited to the net invoice amount or the net amount of the statement of expenses for the assignment.
2. Naktuinbouw will furthermore not be liable for any damage resulting from breach by third parties engaged by Naktuinbouw. Naktuinbouw assumes and if necessary hereby stipulates that each assignment entitles it to accept any limitation of liability by third parties also on behalf of the customer.
3. These General Terms and Conditions may be invoked not only by Naktuinbouw but also by all of the persons who are engaged in the performance by Naktuinbouw of any assignment of the customer.
4. All assignments, including additional assignments and follow-up assignments, will exclusively be accepted and performed by or on behalf of Naktuinbouw. Articles 7:404 (obligation of the contractor to perform the assignment itself) and 7:407(2) (joint and several liability upon the acceptance of an assignment by Naktuinbouw together with a third party) of the Dutch Civil Code will not apply.
5. Naktuinbouw will also not be liable towards the customer for any loss of or damage to information, documentation and/or materials due to actions of third parties.
6. The stipulations in these General Terms and Conditions are made also for the benefit of the Directors of Naktuinbouw and of all of the persons who work or have worked for Naktuinbouw.
7. The customer indemnifies Naktuinbouw against all claims from third parties, including the reasonable costs of legal assistance, that are in any way related to or in any way result from the work performed for the customer, except in the case of willfulness or gross negligence on the part of Naktuinbouw.
8. The customer will provide Naktuinbouw in time with all of the information and data and will co-operate to the best of its ability in all actions that are necessary in Naktuinbouw's opinion to properly perform and complete the assignment. If the customer consists of several legal entities, each one of them will be jointly and severally liable towards Naktuinbouw for the fulfillment of the customer's obligations.

Article 3. Confidentiality

Naktuinbouw will observe confidentiality with regard to all of the information provided by the customer.

Article 4. Returning documentation

1. All documentation made available to Naktuinbouw by the customer may be collected at Naktuinbouw by the customer after notice of termination of the relationship between Naktuinbouw and the customer has been given, or may be sent to the customer by post, for the customer's account and risk. If the customer fails to collect that documentation within a period of six months after the aforesaid notice or fails to request that it be returned to it, Naktuinbouw will have the right to destroy that documentation.
2. Any plant and other materials to be tested that are made available to Naktuinbouw will, in principle, not be returned after completion of the test or the assignment, but will be destroyed, unless the customer stipulates upon giving the assignment or prior to the test that the material must be returned upon completion of the test or the assignment.

Article 5. Tests, assessments and potting of materials

1. Naktuinbouw will determine within the context of the requests for testing/assessment of material the time and the manner in which the test(s) or assessment(s) will be performed.
2. The summary of the outcome of the testing or assessment activities provided by Naktuinbouw in the context of the tests/assessments referred to in the preceding paragraph will relate only to the samples tested and therefore not to the batch of material in question, unless Naktuinbouw indicates otherwise.
3. The customer fully indemnifies Naktuinbouw against any claims from the holders of plant breeders' rights, licensees and third parties, including claims for damages concerning the actions performed or to be performed by Naktuinbouw at the instructions of and for the benefit of the customer, related to the testing/assessment of samples in the broadest sense of the words.
4. In the event of possible contamination with a quarantine organism, Naktuinbouw will be obligated under the Plantenziektenwet (Plant Diseases Act) on request to provide the duly authorised officials of the Plantenziektenkundige Dienst (Plant Protection Service) with all of the information that they reasonably require in order to perform their work.
5. Pathogens isolated by Naktuinbouw itself from plant material, seed or other material submitted for testing will become the property of Naktuinbouw.
6. DNA profiles obtained through molecular marker analysis from plant material, seed, micro-organisms or other material submitted for testing will be saved by Naktuinbouw in a database. These profiles can be used by Naktuinbouw for applications of public interest.

Article 6. Payment

1. Invoices and provisional invoices must be paid not later than within 30 days after the invoice date, without any right to discount or settlement, also in the event of bankruptcy, at the office of Naktuinbouw or by means of remittance to a bank or giro account specified by the latter.
2. If the customer has not paid within the period specified in paragraph 1 or a period later agreed on, it will be in default by operation of law and Naktuinbouw will have the right without any further warning or notice of default to charge the customer interest at a rate of 1% a month, part of a month being counted as a full month, as from the due date until the date of payment in full, without prejudice to Naktuinbouw's other rights. Naktuinbouw will in that case have the right to decide not to perform or further perform the assignment or to suspend such performance until the amount due has been paid in full, including interest and costs.
3. All costs arising from collection in or out of court of a claim against the other party will be for the customer's account.
4. The out-of-court costs of collection are fixed in advance at 15% of the invoice amount, subject to a minimum of € 225,- if third parties are engaged in the collection.
5. Any and all claims that Naktuinbouw has against the customer will fall due immediately if and in so far as the customer is in default of payment, and in the event of bankruptcy, the application for a suspension of payments and the cessation or liquidation of the customer's business.

Article 8. Applicable law and choice of forum

1. All offers, order confirmations, assignments or other agreements or projects to which Naktuinbouw is a party or in which it is otherwise involved, as well as the application or interpretation of these General Terms and Conditions, will in all cases be governed by Dutch law.
2. Any and all disputes related to or arising from offers, order confirmations, assignments or other agreements or projects to which Naktuinbouw is a party or in which it is otherwise involved will be settled in the first instance by the competent court of The Hague, the Netherlands.
3. In the event of a dispute regarding the interpretation of these General Terms and Conditions, the Dutch text shall be decisive.
